Clubs

I trust you will agree that our exceptionally varied, comprehensive and exciting extra-curricular activities offer continues to be a significant strength at Westbourne, with staff volunteering to give their time freely to enhance the broad, balanced and rounded education of all children. This is something I am extremely proud of and know how it contributes greatly to our school vision: **A Thriving & Flourishing Childhood - Belonging, Excellence, Success and Happiness**. I would like to thank all staff in advance for their dedication and commitment to providing a wide range of opportunities outside of school hours; I would also like to thank Mr Jiggins and Mrs Martyn for arranging and managing the timetable, including the booking process!

Timetables

There are **two separate timetables**: an Infant Club timetable and a Junior Club timetable.

1) **An INFANT ONLY timetable** (the Infant Clubs will run on a half-term basis over the three terms: Autumn 1, Autumn 2 and Spring Term 1; Spring Term 2, Summer Term 1 and Summer Term 2). This means that the children will have the opportunity to attend three different clubs led by their teachers throughout the year.

2) **A JUNIOR ONLY timetable** which will very much follow the same layout as previous years and will run across the whole Autumn term (rather than on a half-termly basis like Infant Clubs).

Please read the important information about dates and timings on the timetables.

Logistics

- The attached timetable will be shared with your child on Monday, so they can decide which club to attend;
- We have organised **some** very popular, capacity-limited and over-subscribed **clubs on a rota basis**, so as to ensure fairer access to all children;



- Out-of-hours clubs require you to complete the **online permission slip** in order to attend;
- A **Parentmail Form** will be sent out on **Tuesday 8th September between 8:00pm and 9pm**. Capacity-limited clubs accessible to multiple classes will be sent out at the same time, so as to ensure fairer access (**on a first-come, first-served basis**); please check your Parentmail FORMS folder, not just the Inbox.
- Please ensure you **only** enter your child in **one club per afternoon** and make a note of the closing date to sign up (**Thursday 10th September at 12 noon**) – we had many issues with double, or even triple bookings last year, which caused children to miss out on available clubs!
- Clubs will start the week after next - w/b 14th September 2026 - and will end in the w/e 27th November 2026.

It is essential that all parents follow these guidelines, so that we can maximise and optimise access for all children to this fantastic array of clubs!
