July Attendance – Infant and Junior Classes of the Month

Cricket: Westbourne 6s Final 2026!

After 14 exciting matches with runs and wickets galore, the annual Westbourne 6s cricket competition culminated on Monday with a final battle between England and South Africa. Each team included at least one player from Year 3 to Year 6 and at least one girl and one boy – they had battled through the last 16, quarter finals and semi finals to make it to the ultimate match!

Batting first, England struggled to make early runs but finished the first two overs with the first boundary of the final – a big 6 by Benji! The first 10 of the match was scored by Zion as the ball sailed over the fence of the top cage before Aadhvik came in to dominate the final overs, scoring 47 off 12 balls, with three 10s and two 6s! South Africa were set a daunting total of 272 to win...would it be enough?!

Aadhav and Prahan started the run chase with style, recording 42 runs off their two overs, meaning England had to tighten up their bowling to hold onto a chance of victory. 10 well-bowled deliveries kept the South African scoring at bay until Aadhy finally unleashed his power with two 10s off the final 2 balls of his overs. That left South Africa needing just 7 to win from 12 balls....but with the added jeopardy of losing 5 runs every time a wicket was taken. The tension mounted as the crowd watched on, eager to see who would emerge victorious. Fawzaan and Avika, however, coped admirably with the pressure and completed their innings with a huge 10, meaning South Africa emerged as victors with 292 runs!

What a great final to complete a super summer of lunchtime cricket! Congratulations to both England and South Africa for making it to the final and making the match such an exciting spectacle! Well done to all of the children who took part and umpired and scored – approximately 100 in total – for many it was their first introduction to competitive cricket and long may they continue!

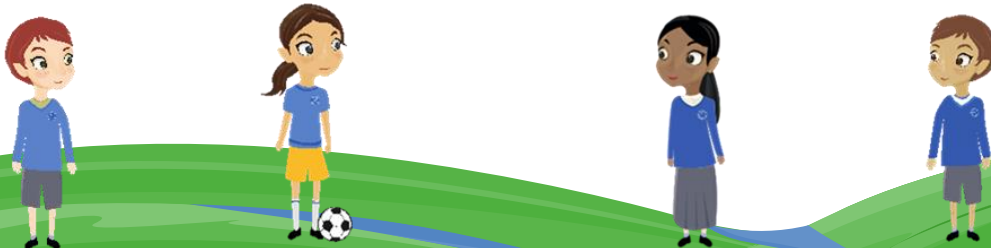

Find your family's summer offer

The government is cutting VAT from 20% to 5% on family days out — from cinema and theatre tickets to attractions, and children's meals out. Less to pay, more summer to enjoy.

25 June – 1 September 2026, right across the UK

Great British Summer Savings

Rising prices can make life's little treats harder to afford, especially during the school holidays when costs build up for families. This Government is determined to help, and that is why last month the Chancellor announced the Great British Summer Savings scheme.

From 25 June to 1 September 2026, the Government is temporarily cutting VAT from 20% to 5% on children's meals in restaurants, children and family tickets to cinemas, theatres, concerts and exhibitions, and admission to a wide range of attractions. Combined with free bus travel during August for children aged 5 to 15 in England, families and young people will be able to enjoy experiences that make summer special, including visits to the kinds of cultural and educational attractions that enrich children's lives outside the classroom.

Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme

Dear Parent/Carer,

We're pleased to let you know that the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme is returning this summer, running from 27 July to 28 August.

The programme is funded by the Department for Education and delivered locally by Sutton Council. It offers free holiday activities and nutritious meals for children and young people who are eligible for benefits-related Free School Meals.

Children attending the programme can enjoy a wide range of activities, including:

- Sports and physical activities
- Arts, crafts and creative workshops
- Music, dance and drama
- Outdoor adventures and games
- Healthy meals provided during each session
- Opportunities to make new friends and learn new skills in a safe and supportive environment

If your child is eligible, you should have received a HAF voucher with details of how to book activities.

If you think your child may be eligible but you have not received a voucher, or if you would like further information, please contact the school office.

Please note: All sessions (except adult gym use) must be booked in advance.
